As part of our effort to keep the health and well-being of our students and staff a priority, Cumberland County Charter Schools Network has recently completed lead testing in all of the drinking water outlets in each of its schools. This testing, or plumbing profile, was completed in accord with New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) regulations.


Of the water samples obtained through the charter school network, four outlets tested above the lead action level established by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for lead in drinking water (15ug/1 [ppb]). All effected outlets were located in the administrative offices and not within the school building. The table below identifies the remedial actions immediately taken by the network to reduce the levels of lead in that location:

<i>Location</i>	<i>Remedial Action</i>
CCCSN Administrative Building (4 outlets)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sign placed indicating the outlet is to be used for "Handwashing Only."</li> <li>2. Retesting.(Retesting results will be forthcoming)</li> </ol>
