Dear Parents/Guardians,

The New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) under Chapter 14 N.J.A.C. 8:57-4 mandates the following two vaccines for your incoming 6th grader.

1. Tdap vaccine (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis) Every child entering or attending Grade 6 shall have received one dose of Tdap given no earlier than the 10th birthday and five (5) years have elapsed from the last DTP/DTaP or Td dose.
2. Meningococcal vaccine every child entering or attending Grade 6 shall have received one dose of meningococcal vaccine (Menactra or Menveo).

Parents must provide their child's COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION RECORD that includes these vaccines PRIOR TO ENTRANCE INTO SIXTH GRADE.

The NJDOH requires the dose be received within TWO WEEKS of the 11th birthday.

According to N.J.A.C. 8:57- 2, a principal, administrator or person in charge of a school shall not admit or retain any child whose parents have not submitted acceptable evidence of immunizations.

As of July 31, 2019 we have not received documentation that the above two vaccines have been administered to your child. In order for your child to return to school proper documentation must be presented to school nurse.
