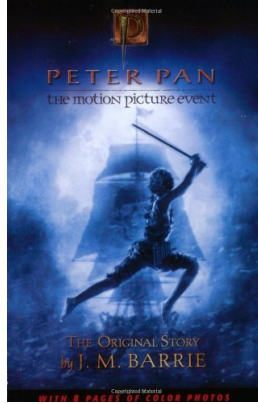

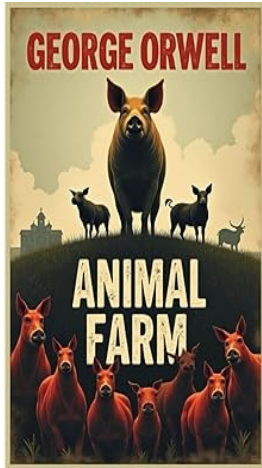

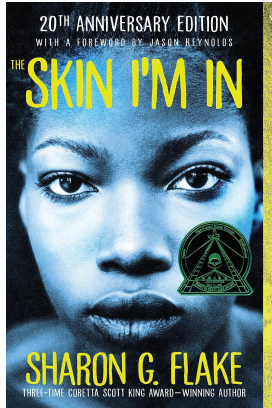

7th & 8th Grade Summer Reading One-Pager Project

A one-pager is a creative way to show your understanding of a book. Everything goes onto one sheet of paper: drawings, words, symbols, and quotes.

Your One-Pager Must Include:

- Book title & author's name - big and easy to see.
- A key quote - choose a sentence that stood out and explain why.
- A main character's name - and at least 3 traits with evidence.
- An illustration - draw the setting, a key scene, or a symbol.
- Theme or message - 1-2 sentences about the big idea or lesson.
- 5+ important words - that represent the book's ideas or mood.

Design Tips:

- Fill the page - no empty white space!
- Use color, borders, and creativity.
- Organize text and visuals clearly.

Reflection (back or small box):

Write 4-5 sentences about what you liked most and who you'd recommend the book to and why.

Suggested One-Pager Layout:

Divide your page into sections:

- Top: Title & Author
- Left: Key Quote + explanation
- Right: Character traits + evidence
- Center: Illustration or symbol
- Bottom: Theme/message + 5 important words
